To Our Members

Attention is called to the following rules:

1. That all account books of the church for the previous year be closed definitely after the second Sunday in January.
2. That the financial secretaries of the various auxiliary societies of the church present to the clerk of the session an alphabetical list of the contributors, keeping together the names of the members of every family.
3. We invite attention to the following rule of our denomination: That every church member be required to contribute to the financial support of the church "as the Lord hath prospered him." Willful neglect of this duty is unfaithfulness to the Lord's cause, and proves the negligent one to be unworthy of a place among the flock of Christ. Furthermore, in the future, we prohibit the clerk from issuing a church letter to any one who has made no contribution to the cause for any single year.

These annual church reports are mirrors wherein we see reflected our religious character. And we have reasons to be thankful that the church record of 1920 reveals that we have been "neither barren nor unfruitful in the service of our Lord Jesus Christ."

Our contribution to Missions has increased, and in addition, we were privileged to contribute over \$400 (from both churches) to the needy ones in Europe and in China. Every contributor to these worthy causes has undoubtedly experienced the truthfulness of the Savior's word, that "it is more blessed to give than to receive."

Let us, in Salem, make our goal for Missions in 1921, \$1,000!

It is worthy of note that we are now one with the Presbyterian Church in the U. S. A. Gradually we will adjust ourselves to the new and efficient methods of the English body, and thereby do a larger and a more potent work for the establishment of the Kingdom of Heaven upon the earth.

One marked advance was the uniting of our Women's Missionary Society with the Women's Missionary Society of Lima Presbytery. A wider, a clearer, missionary vision will come to our church as a result of this forward step on the part of our Women's Society.

Another matter of unusual interest which came to pass in 1920 was the coming of the Horeb friends into our midst. We were glad to welcome them, and we rejoice that they have so naturally taken their place in the "Mother Church." We desire each one of them to keep in vital touch with every department of our church service and to shun the feeling that, owing to a large church membership, the work can succeed without them. It can not. The church of God suffers in proportion to the number of its members who lag and are indifferent to their spiritual, social and financial duties.

Indeed, the revival we need in Salem and Zion is to have every enrolled member aroused, so that such an one may not be "slothful in spiritual business, but rather fervent in spirit, serving the Lord."
