TO OUR MEMBERS

Attention is called to the following rules:

1. That all account books of the church for the previous year be closed definitely after the second Sunday in January.

Though the financial depression, prevalent throughout the country, was keenly felt by our own agricultural community, still this report will show that by our contributions we made 1921 our banner year!

Our goal of a \$1,000 for Missions in 1921 was surpassed; for, including the gift of the Women's Missionary Society to the Lima Presbyterian, our contributions to Missions totaled \$1,053.99! This undoubtedly is indicative of a growth in grace and godliness, because we cannot be spiritually right with God unless we be financially right with Him. They who willfully neglect to support God's Cause, are guilty of robbing Him," Mal. 3:8-12.

Another reason for gratitude is that our number was enhanced by the reception of 3 on confession of faith, and of 14 children, "a godly seed" we hope. May God fulfill unto us His precious promise: "I will pour my spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing upon thine offspring: And they shall spring up as among the grass, as willows by the water courses," Is. 44:3-4.

To that end, let it be remembered that the parents must keep afresh their own personal devotions, and conduct regularly the Family Worship, and persevere in faithfulness to all the established Ordinances of Grace in God's House.

Heaven was enriched by the promotion from our midst of a sweet maiden, a young man in the bloom of life, and of five of our mature, elderly members. Sorely we miss their presence here, but rejoice to know of their eternal presence with the Lord.

It is a significant fact that 1923 will mark the 75th birth-year of Salem church! And we suggest that this auspicious occasion should be celebrated by making further improvements in the basement, by decorating the interior of the church, and by painting the wood-work of the exterior. Perhaps, too, that a Home-coming of Salem's children to a spiritual feast of praise and preaching could be arranged for 1923.

Knowing that we shall never pass the way of 1922 again, let us fill it brimful with loving service to Jesus Christ.
