FOREWORD

Dear Brethren and Sisters:—

We present to you this, another year book of Salem and Zion Churches for your perusal and study.

As we look back upon another year's work, we feel grateful for the hearty and generous response you have given us in a financial way, to carry on the work of God's Kingdom, notwithstanding the fact that the last two years have been much less prosperous in an agricultural sense

While we can not print in a report what our increase was in the last year in a spiritual sense, let us hope that this is an outward manifestation of our Christian faith and love.

The New Era Movement has set a goal of \$1,600.00 for Salem, and \$400.00 for Zion as regards benevolences, and while this looks like a great task before us, "Let us not be weary in well doing; for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not." Let us therefore go forth with a firmer determination than ever to serve our Master.

While we have been deprived of a pastor for a number of months to lead us, may we look forward to the coming of our new minister, and may we hope and pray for renewed activity, and that the joint efforts of pastor and congregation will be crowned with great success.

Attention is called to the following rules:

1. That all account books of the church for the previous year be closed definitely after the second Sunday in January.
2. That the financial secretaries of the various auxiliary societies of the church present to the clerk of the session an

alphabetical list of the contributors, keeping together the names of the members of every family.

3. We invite attention to the following rule of our denomination: That every church member be required to contribute to the financial support of the church "as the Lord hath prospered him." Wilful neglect of this duty is unfaithfulness to the Lord's cause, and proves the negligent one to be unworthy of a place among the flock of Christ. Furthermore, in the future, we prohibit the clerk from issuing a church letter to any one who has made no contribution to the cause for any single year.
