STATISTICAL AND FINANCIAL REPORT

OF THE HANDBELL CHOIRS, JANUARY 10, 1967

The Handbell Choirs of Salem United Presbyterian Church of Venedocia, Ohio now number 5 with 39 people participating. This is an increase over last year. During the year of 1967 these choirs have played 30 times in our own church services and 35 times outside for performances at Grand Rapids, Ohio, Convoy, Rockford, Celina, Moulton, New Knoxville, New Bremen, St. Marys, Wapakoneta, Spencerville, Bath, Lima, Converse, and Monticello, Ohio. They traveled in 1967 a distance of 1,470 miles making their total mileage 2,702 miles. During 1967 they played for 4,299 people outside our own church making the total number of people for whom they have now played 6,777.
