**JANUARY 1969 REPORT OF THE HANDBELL
 CHOIRS FOR SALEM UNITED PRESBYTERIAN
 CHURCH, VENEDOCIA, OHIO**

Our Handbell Program has been a very active part of this church during the year 1968. Last winter we had five choirs. Two ladies choirs, The Lady Belles and The Bell Tones... two girls groups, The Road Ringers and the Chapel Bells... and a boys group, The Bell Boys. In May we gave our second annual Handbell Concert in our home church to a capacity audience from several miles around. In June, nine of our ladies traveled to Appleton, Wisconsin to attend the Area V American Guild of English Handbell Ringers Festival. There they played for a group of 200 Handbell Ringers and also joined in a mass choir with them performing under the direction of the National AGEHR President. Our director, Bartie Jones, as a result of our playing was asked to be consultant at a recent festival in Cleveland, Ohio and was elected Secretary of the Area V AGEHR... covering a five state area.

In September, due to a turnover of members we re-organized our choirs into three larger groups: The Lady Belle Tones, The Road Ringers and the Bell Boys. These choirs practice an hour a week on Tuesdays and some hardy members come in extra times to learn the more skilled performing. We have completely costumed all choirs and have added to our equipment both for traveling and for home use. To date our Hand bell Choirs have traveled a total of over 4,500 miles and played to over 11,000 people outside of our church. If funds can be raised between now and June we would like to take the Road Ringers to the National AGEHR Festival to be held in Pennsylvania.
