We took 12 girls and 5 chaperones to the National Handbell Ringing Festival in Grove City, Pennsylvania in June. There they played before 1200 people and also with 000 other bell ringers. In December of this year we received 13 new bells from Mr. and Mrs. Layton Jenkins in memory of their parents Mr. and Mrs. David W. Rees and Mr. and Mrs. John L. Jenkins. One more large bell has been ordered but not yet received to be included in this gift.
