A Word From the Pastor

After the anniversary celebration of 1998, it would have been easy to make 1999 a year in which we rested, and just coasted along on the memories of the celebrations and reunions. That was hardly the case, though, as the momentum of the anniversary year and the celebration of God's presence with Salem Church throughout the years carried us into an exciting 1999. I would characterize 1999 as a year when we celebrated the present and prepared for the future.

The reasons for celebration of the present were many in 1999: Our growth continued, with average attendance up by 2 people a Sunday, and 15 new members joining us, including 8 young people who were confirmed on Pentecost. Programs continued to grow, with a new Sunday School class for young adults, and increasing participation in existing programs such as junior choir and youth group.

Giving increased over the previous year, and for the first time in several years, income exceeded expenses in 1999. Linda Davis established the Earl Davis Family Memorial Fund with the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) foundation, and the income from this fund will be used to support the music ministry of Salem Church, especially the junior choir and bell programs. Plans were also made to go forward with a lift to provide handicapped accessibility to the building.

In response to the good things happening in the present and in preparation for the future, session instituted a newsletter this year, which is distributed monthly to all members and to friends who attend regularly. The Sounds of Salem made it easier to keep parents and youth informed of upcoming events. The trustees purchased a copy machine for the church, which has received heavy use, not just for the newsletter, but for copying other documents and materials for use in various church programs.

After discussing the need for several years, this Fall the session moved forward with hiring a part-time secretary to prepare the newsletter, bulletin, and help coordinate the calendar for an ever-growing number of groups and activities. The groundwork has been laid to purchase a computer and establish an office at the church.

In the midst of our celebrations of the present and preparations for the future, the ministry and worship of the church continued, providing us with the continuity and strength we needed to face the challenges and opportunities that came our way. We celebrated baptisms, mourned deaths, cared for the sick and grieving, and worshipped God in ways old and new. Amid the changes, we continued to draw our strength from the steadfast faithfulness of God, who never changes, and who will lead us into the new millennium with the same strength and guidance that have carried us through the first 151 years of Salem Church.
